

2019 WILDCAT REUNION

The 2019 all-class Wildcat Reunion was a big success! We had 465 attendees, including alumni and guests from all corners of the U.S. We had attendees from classes of 1939 through 2019 - an 80 year span! Nancy Marriott Austin, class of 1939, who turned 99 this year, was awarded the oldest attendee gift. Special recognition was also given to Evelyn Tudor Roberts (1942) and Louis Pico (1942) as the next oldest attendees. Our youngest attendees were 2019 scholarship recipients Gabrielle Hage, Kinberly Malfavon-Medina, Guadalupe Ramirez and Angel Taylor. We were honored to also have CCSD Superintendent Dr. Jesus Jara and LVHS Principal Ron Guerzon in attendance, plus Jolene Mitchell and Susan Thornton from the Las Vegas Academy. Classes of 1960 through 1964 were honored and had over 90 attendees, including classmates and guests. Classes of 1954, 1959, 1964, 1969, 1979, 1984 and 1989 also celebrated their "significant" reunions with us. Class of 69 had the most of any class, with a total of 64 attendees.



MEET HOWARD PINK, A 1961 ALUMNI . . .



I have been a French Horn musician for most of my life. I started out playing a horn at Red Rock Elementary, then I attended J.C. Fremont Junior High and continued with my music upon entering Las Vegas High, under Band Director of A. B. Larson. During my four years in the band, I also ran the lunch time popcorn machine and was the student conductor of the band. After graduation, I attended Arizona State University on a band scholarship and was a French Horn Performance Major. While at ASU, I also played horn with the Phoenix





Symphony for 3 years. After ASU, I joined the Peace Corps for a special music program and went to La Paz, Bolivia, South America, where I played in the Bolivian National Symphony. The orchestra was being directed by Jerry Brown, a former ASU music student. I also taught music in three schools and became quite proficient in Spanish, thanks to my LVHS Spanish classes with Sergio Alvarez. After the Peace Corps, I served my country in two U.S. Army Bands: 6th Headquarters Band at the Presidio of San Francisco and the 8th Infantry Division Band in Bad Kreuznach, Germany. Once my service to my country ended, I finally got to begin my professional, orchestral career. I played horn with a variety of orchestras. My longest performing job was with the Louisiana Philharmonic, based in New Orleans, LA for 33 years. During that time, I also developed and performed my solo, educational/entertaining show, "Howard Pink and His Musical Garden Hoses." I was blown out of New Orleans in August, 2005 by Hurricane Katrina and evacuated to Nashville, TN where I retired from my professional career. I then played in a community band for 10 years. I have continued to perform my garden hose show, both here in TN and going back to Louisiana for summer library reading programs. (Submitted by Howard Pink)




YEARBOOKS

The Spectrum group started off the meeting with a wonderful performance.


