

I look forward to serving and expanding our ability to fund the needs of our campus and its students long into the future.



Members of Classes of 1980 & 1981 celebrating at the 2019 Wildcat Reunion



SCHOLARSHIPS

The LVHSAA awarded a total of \$28,100 in scholarships to 18 recipients this year - twelve to deserving seniors planning to attend a Southern Nevada university or college, and for the first time, we awarded continuing scholarships to prior year recipients (six 2019 graduates)! This was the 12th consecutive year that we have awarded scholarships, bringing the total to \$159,100 to 86 recipients! We are able to do this only thanks to the generous donations from our alumni! 


